

24. That 17 local FM stations in Sweden are now broadcasting Hanna's Café (WoH) and for the new Hannah's House starting in Sweden as God brings many immigrants together to study His Word.

25. For the partnership with Life Now and for the women who are writing scripts for PH's new discipleship program. Please continue to pray that this program will go on the air in 2011.

26. For ERF in Germany, Switzerland and Austria; NOREA in Denmark, Norway and Sweden; Messengers in Finland; and TWR partners in Asia, Brazil, Canada, Holland and the UK for their continued financial support for WoH programs. Without it, these languages would not be on the air reaching women around the world.

27. For PH's International WoH script-writing team of volunteers in Australia led by Ros Atkinson. They are providing program scripts that are translated into over 50 languages. "God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them" (Hebrews 6:10).

28. For partnerships with other ministries (Burnham Foundation, Stonecroft Ministries, International Orality Network and Campus Crusade for Christ) about working together to reach women with God's love and care.

29. For lives that are changed after hearing about God's love through the loving actions of PH's staff and volunteers and by listening to the WoH program. "I was in a hopeless situation. I couldn't take it anymore so I was about to commit suicide but I heard your program. It gave me hope to know that someone cares for me and that He gave His life to save me. I've never felt so relieved in my life. Thank you for what you do!" (Philippines)

30. Thousands of prisoners who receive hope, joy and salvation through the love shown to them in practical ways and Bible studies by those who visit them in Angola, Albania, Cambodia, Ivory Coast, Nepal, Paraguay, Portugal, and in 45 prisons in Thailand and through the teaching they receive from the WoH programs in countries around the world.

"Glorify the LORD with me; let us exalt his name together...I sought the LORD, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears...The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit" Psalm 34:3, 4, 18.

*P*roject Hannah's Prayer Movement is experiencing a beautiful leap of growth around the world. Women and men are experiencing the joy of praying for others. Whether they are family members, neighbors or people far away, supporting them in prayer allows them to be a part of God's global work.

New prayer groups are starting in Albania, Bolivia, China, Finland and Tanzania. Around 200 women in Colombia fasted and prayed with hundreds of others around the world during PH's 40-Day Annual Season of Prayer and Fasting. Special prayer gatherings and retreats took place in Brazil, Finland, Ethiopia, Kenya and Mozambique.

As God's people pray and speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, women and girls are rescued from the grips of evil and lifted into a brighter future. Around the globe many are experiencing God's love and care through the acts of those who take the time to teach them God's Word, to guide them in how to better care for their families and train them with skills so they can financially support themselves. God is at work and lives are being changed. "Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done. Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts" (Psalm 105:1-2).

Let us not give up, but continue the work of prayer so that many will have a true relationship with Christ. Pray for families that are falling apart and individuals who are hopelessly struggling without biblical principles and godly values in their relationships, work and daily lives.

Give praise and thanksgiving..

1. That in 2010 Project Hannah's (PH) *Women of Hope* (WoH) program went on the air in Russian, Oromo and Umbundu and is now available in 56 languages. Please continue to pray for these programs as God uses them to touch the lives of women around the world.
2. That God has heard our prayers, and many governments are doing more to fight sex-tourism, sex-trafficking, child bride practices, honor-killings, poverty and many other horrible difficulties women face. Please continue to pray.
3. That Ruth Mbennah accepted the position as PH's Africa Regional Coordinator and has been traveling extensively to encourage existing ministry teams and intercessors and explore having WoH available in Ghana, Mali and Tanzania.
4. That Marli and Ruth met with leaders of several ministries in Kenya and Ethiopia, spoke in churches and at women's conferences and met with PH staff, listeners and intercessors. They also met with leaders from Tanzania who desire to have WoH in Tanzanian Swahili in the near future. Please continue to pray for these ministries and for the women seeking help at the Addis Ababa Fistula Hospital and many who struggle with complications of HIV/AIDS.
5. That PH is reaching out to women through social media such as the new website, Facebook page and iPhone application.
6. That the English version of Marli's book, *When Hope Wins*, was published. Praise the Lord for the marvelous work He has done in the lives of the women in the book and thousands of others around the world. Pray that this book will touch many more lives for Christ. "Jesus did many other things as well. If every one of them were written down, I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written" (John 21:25).
7. For the women and men who gave their lives to Christ after listening to WoH radio programs, being visited by PH staff who shared God's love with them, during prayer groups and conferences or through PH mercy ministries.

8. That over 40 women from Bolivia, Brazil, Paraguay, United States and Uruguay met together at PH's Americas Forum in Curitiba, Brazil, for a time of encouragement, training, reporting, worshiping and planning for future ministries.
9. For Project Hannah's 13 years of ministry reaching out to women through awareness, prayer and radio programming. Praise the Lord for intercessors who joined PH's annual 40-day Season of Prayer and Fasting and who faithfully pray through the monthly prayer requests. "Look at the nations and watch and be utterly amazed. For I am going to do something in your days that you would not believe even if you were told" (Habakkuk 1:5).
10. That Marli was invited to speak to the women at the International Orality Network (ION) conference, Stonecroft STIR Impact, the Lausanne Movement Third World Evangelization Congress in South Africa and the Women's Prayer Summit in New York City, bringing awareness of the broken and persecuted lives of women around the globe and proclaiming restoration, love and hope in Christ.
11. For the thousands of people involved in PH prayer groups who meet regularly for prayer, reach out to women and do evangelism in prisons, maternity wards, hospitals, orphanages and centers distributing food, clothes and baby items, giving hope to women and their families.
12. That WoH programs are heard on the phone in Spanish and Thai as part of the ERF's telephone ministry for immigrants in Germany encouraging them spiritually and in their daily situations.
13. For faithful single women who are serving God in difficult places. Pray for their safety, health and family relationships. Also pray that others will come alongside them to encourage and support them.
14. For God's sustaining grace on PH staff members who have been very ill or have lost loved ones this year. "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness" (2 Corinthians 12:9).
15. For WoH listeners who have invited neighbors and family members to listen to the program with them.

- Give thanks for the many doctors, counselors and other professionals who give of their time to speak on WoH programs, give seminars or training to women's groups and use their gifts to lift up women.
16. That mothers and widows struggling to survive are receiving love and help from PH's staff and prayer groups through gifts of food, clothing and other financial help.
 17. For the unknown answers to our prayers and for the many lives that have been touched by God.
 18. That the WoH programs are aired on TWR and PH websites and Internet sites of partners in Bengali, Bulgarian, Danish, Hindi, English, Finnish, Gujarati, Korean, Mandarin, Oriya, Portuguese, Romanian, Russian, Spanish, Swedish, Tamil and Thai reaching women who are at work, isolated or living far from home.
 19. For Norwegians who gave funds for a car for PH's Kenya team to visit prayer groups and establish new ones.
 20. For the many pastors, husbands and TWR staff who support and serve PH's staff and volunteers around the world. TWR-Africa's Director, Dr. Emmanuel Mbennah, was used by God to bring hope to the hearts of the women of Ghana in September for the launching of PH's ministry there. Edmund Spieker served the women at the Americas Forum every day in many ways.
 21. For over 340 radio stations in Latin America that air PH's Spanish WoH program for free. Pray for God to restore TWR's Director of Hispanic Ministries, Lemuel Larrosa's, health so he can continue to speak up for women and passionately encourage stations to reach out to women in their areas.
 22. That Australia National Director, Garrison Pearse, is excited about expanding PH's ministry there and has appointed Tita Cook as PH's Australia Coordinator. Pray for God's wisdom and strength as Tita takes responsibility for PH's Women's Ministry development.
 23. For Rebekah, PH's new Korea Coordinator and producer of their WoH program. Pray for God's wisdom and strength to be upon Rebekah as she leads and works with a team of volunteers.
